WINKFIELD RELIEF LANDING GROUND	Bracknell Forest	A former World War Two military airfield, opened in 1941 and closed in 1945. The wartime airfield had grass surfaced landing areas of about 980 by 630 yards. It had limited facilities: 5 Blister aircraft hangars and temporary accommodation for 66 Royal Air Force personnel. Its role was as a Relief Landing Ground for Tiger Moth aircraft of 18 Elementary Flying Training School based at Fair Oaks. By 1975 the site was a radio and space research station, it still had this function in 2002....
WINKFIELD PLACE	Bracknell Forest	House, built in the late 18th century, with later alterations. 3 storeys, stucco with hipped slate roof. The stuccoed front has a parapet, moulded strings at first and second floor cills. The entrance door is under a prostyle Tuscan porch, with pediment. There are mid 19th century, 2 storey additions to the right....
MONUMENT NO. 247748	Bracknell Forest	Bowl barrow
SWINLEY PARK	Bracknell Forest	Medieval deer park, depicted on Norden's map of 1607 as Swinley Rails with a lodge and fishpond. Fragments of the park pale remain as do pond bays of two fishponds, but there is no trace of the lodge...

MONUMENT NO. 247772	Bracknell Forest	Icehouse Hill
ROMAN ENCLOSURE AND CREMATION CEMETERY	Bracknell Forest	An enclosure and Roman cremation cemetery of the second half of the 1st century AD was found in 1773 and 1783....
MONUMENT NO. 247872	Bracknell Forest	A group of four possible barrows and a rectangular platform were located about 100 metres north of the Devil's Highway. The main barrow, and the most convincing, lies just east of a firebreak track. At the east tip of the ridge, about 12 metres from the main barrow, another barrow occurs. It is not more than 1 metre high and between 20-22 metres in diameter. Two other barrows were noted in excess of 20 metres in diameter. West of the main barrow, a low platform was noted. The maximum dimensions are 24 metres east-west by 20 metres and the top measures 18 x 12 metres ...

ST MARYS CHURCH	Bracknell Forest	A 13th century church, re-roofed in 1592, tower constructed during the 17th century. Nave, divided down centre by oak posts, south chapel, south porch, tower at south-west angle, chancel, north vestry and organ chamber. Extensions also carried out by G.E Street in 1858. ...
MONUMENT NO. 251454	Bracknell Forest	Possible Roman settlement.

MONUMENT NO. 251455	Bracknell Forest	Roman Settlement, Medieval and Post Medieval finds
WINTER QUARTER CAMP	Bracknell Forest	The site of a Second World War prisoner of war camp on the edge of Swinley Park, known as Winter Quarter Camp 7. It consisted of approximately 20 huts in a guard's compound, 26 huts in a prisoner's compound and a football pitch enclosed by a double perimeter fence. It is referenced as originally being an internment camp for alien and enemy civilians, then holding Italian and German servicemen as prisoners of war. It possibly became a work camp, as prisoners are referenced as working as labourers on nearby farms. It would have been in use between 1939 and 1948....
ASCOT WEST STATION	Bracknell Forest	Site of railway station on the Wokingham and Staines branch line, opened in 1846. Closed since 1977...
KILBEES FARMHOUSE	Bracknell Forest	C16 farmhouse of two-storeys. Timber-framed with brick nogging.
BRACKNELL ROAD	Bracknell Forest	Milestone of circa 1770 at south-east corner of junction of Bracknell Road and Church Lane. Square with pyramidal top. Inscribed on the north-west face: HYDE PARK CORNER 26 MILES / READING 14..
LONDON ROAD	Bracknell Forest	Milestone of circa 1760 approximately 50m east of junction with Swinley Road. Square with pyramidal top. Inscribed on the north face: LONDON 26 MILES / READING 13 MILES....
LONDON ROAD	Bracknell Forest	Early 19th century milestone 200m south-east of junction with Broad Lane. Stone with rounded top Inscription reads: LONDON 27 MILES / READING 12 MILES.. ...
LOVEL LANE	Bracknell Forest	Early 19th century milestone approx 230m south-east of junction with Hatchet Lane . Square with pyramidal top. Inscribed on the north-east face: HYDE PARK CORNER 24 MILES / READING 16 MILES....
PIGEONHOUSE LANE	Bracknell Forest	Early 19th century milestone 450 metres south-east of junction with Brazier's Lane. Square with pyramidal top. Inscribed on the north-east face: HYDE PARK CORNER 25 MILES / READING 15 MILES. There is also a benchmark....
ASCOT PLACE	Bracknell Forest	Grotto situated in grounds of Ascot Place, south of house, at the west end of the lake. It is an ornamental romantic grotto built about 1750 by Robert Turnbull....
ASCOT PLACE	Bracknell Forest	Landscape park, pleasure grounds and gardens to Ascot Place, a country house constructed 1770s-80s. The park and pleasure grounds are contemporary with the house, but the gardens were developed during the late 19th and early 20th century, possibly by Miss Ann Ferard and C C Ferard. Further gardens were laid out circa 1900-10..
ASCOT PLACE	Bracknell Forest	Mesolithic blades and flints found beside the Blackmore Stream between Ascot Place and Brookside House. The whereabouts of the finds is currently (2011) unknown....
THE VALE	Bracknell Forest	Early/mid C19 house of two-storeys, in Georgian style.
